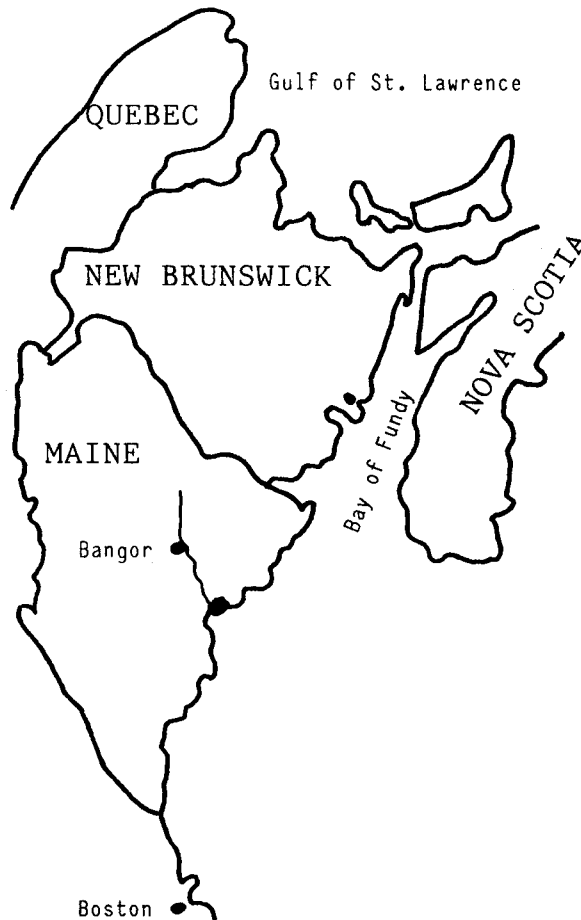


MY BROTHER SAM IS DEAD
